

SCHS DRESS CODE POLICY
2016-2017

Students must be in dress code when they arrive on campus for school, and until they leave campus at dismissal.

1. **Hair color** – Mohawks are to be no longer than 3” and no unnatural hair color will be permitted. A student with unnatural hair color will be given 2 days to fix it. If after 2 days the color is not fixed, the student will be placed in ISS until it is dyed back to a natural color.
2. **Hats**- Students are never allowed to wear a hat inside, and are only permitted to wear a hat outside if the temperature is <50 degrees. If a student is wearing a hat when it is not permitted, the hat will be taken and the student will receive a Wednesday detention and the hat will be returned at the end of the day. The **2nd offense** the hat will be taken and a parent will have to pick up the hat, the student will receive ISS.
3. **Face Piercings**- Students are allowed to wear a clear spacer in their piercings that does not have balls on the end. If a student is caught with a piercing rather than a spacer the piercing will be confiscated and the student will receive a detention. If the student is caught a **2nd offense** the student will be assigned to ISS until he/she has the proper clear spacer for the piercing.
4. **Polo shirts**- Must have a collar and must be solid navy blue, white, yellow/gold, maroon, grey, or black. The shirt may have a small logo on the chest, but may not have stripes of any kind. Shirts must be down to the waist, but not be longer than the fingertips, or skin tight (skin showing). Vests and hoodies may be worn over the shirt, or a coat which has a liner as long as the uniform shirt is visible at all times.
5. **Oxford/Button down shirts**- Must have a collar and must be a solid navy blue, white, yellow/gold, maroon, grey, or black (no light denim). The shirt must be buttoned from the chest down and may not be tied at the bottom. Shirts may be sleeveless; however the straps must be at least three fingers thick.
6. **Under shirts/Cami**- Must be solid navy blue, white, yellow/gold, maroon, grey, or black and be worn under any clothing that is sheer.
7. **Shorts**- Must be khaki, navy blue, dark denim jeans, grey, or black. Shorts need to be mid-thigh in length, and be hemmed with no frays, holes, etc.
8. **Pants**- Must be khaki, navy blue, dark denim jeans, grey, or black. A small logo or embroidery is permitted on the back pockets of the pants; however no writing is permitted elsewhere. Pants must be worn at the waist, and may not be worn low enough where underwear or skin may be seen. If a student’s pants are caught being worn below the waist, the student will receive a detention for the **1st offense**, and ISS for the **2nd offense**, along with being issued a belt from the dean’s office for the day.

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9. **Skirts-** Must be khaki, navy blue, dark denim, grey, white, maroon, gold, or black and mid-thigh in length. A uniform shirt must be worn with a skirt.
10. **Dresses-** Must be grey, black, navy blue, yellow/gold, maroon, khaki, white, or dark denim and worn with the proper undergarments. If the dress is sleeveless, the straps must be at least three fingers thick and come up under the armpits. The dress must be able to stand alone with dress code policy, in other words, a strapless dress cannot be worn with a cardigan over it.
11. **Spirit shirts-** On Fridays, any school issued shirt by a club, sport, or organization may be worn. In addition, St. Cloud sports teams t-shirts may be worn or a college logo shirt. No professional team shirts may be worn. SCHS PE Shirts are acceptable.
12. **Outer Garments-** Hoodies and Jackets may be worn inside the buildings or on days that the weather is <50 degrees. However, when inside, the hoodie or jacket must be taken off **and** the school uniform collar must be visible at all times.
13. **Shoes-** Student may not wear slippers or platform shoes, and must wear tennis shoes for PE class.
14. **Athletic Teams/Clubs-** On the day of a club event or athletic competition, the players or members may wear a club or team t-shirt, if the event has been properly placed on the school-wide event calendar. When appropriate, jerseys may be worn or a warm-up jacket. If an athletic team chooses to dress up for game day, they must wear a dress code shirt and pants, but may wear any school appropriate tie. Cheerleaders may wear their cheer uniform top with dress code shorts or pants.
15. **Dress Down Days-** Pajamas, slipper, spandex, and yoga pants are not permitted. Any dress down day must be approved by administration.
16. **Attending After School Events-** Students may not wear any clothing with inappropriate writing, or excessive skin. If the student's clothing or behavior is an issue, the student may be asked to leave the event and suspension from attending any future activities may occur.
